2010 RULES FOR COMMERCIAL EXHIBITS AND CONCESSIONS

- All concessions must be in full operation the following hours: Saturday, September 18th, 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM and Sunday, September 19th, 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM. Inside booths in Fair Hall will be closed down at 7:00 Saturday night for security reasons.
- Please provide a copy of any needed insurance with application, if it applies to your operation. Booth will not be accepted without this insurance.**
- Each booth will be charged a rate of \$50 or \$100 for each location. The Booth fee is not refundable.
- All concessions must be fully equipped and ready for operation during these hours. However, you may open earlier and stay longer depending on crowd attendance.
- You will be responsible, during the Fair, to maintain the area surrounding your booth. Failure to do so may result in closing of your booth.
- You will be allowed to sell only what is specified and granted by agreement and application. This includes water.**
- No sound equipment such as P.A. systems or record players allowed.
- No roving the grounds to sell your product will be allowed. Anyone selling on the grounds will be considered a concession and must abide by the rules.
- All concessions will operate only in assigned areas as agreed. Outdoor booths will be furnished 110 electricity if needed and an area approximately 12' X 12'. No tables, tents, or booths will be provided. Indoor booths will be furnished 110 electricity if needed and an area approximately 10' X 10'. **Indoor booths only may rent a table and 2 chairs for \$5.00 for 2 days. We have a limited amount of tables for inside only. You will be responsible for providing your own back drops if needed.**
- The concession committee shall have complete authority and approval on items sold, and will be selective to insure an adequate range of services available.
- An infraction or failure to abide by these rules and guidelines can result in the closing of your booth.
- The Medina County Fair Association assumes no liability for products sold by concessionaires.
- Concessionaires are responsible to the sales tax on their sales.
- Any concession using and/or selling a product that requires ice must purchase the ice from the Medina County Fair Association, Inc.
- All vehicles owned by concessionaires and/or workers must be parked in the parking lot during the hours of 10:00 am to 8:00 pm. The only exception will be emergency First Aid Vehicles.
