## FOOD CONCESSIONS 2010

1. All concessions must be in full operation the following hours: Saturday, September 18<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Sunday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
2. Please do not bring food, drinks or alcoholic beverages on the Fair Grounds. We offer free parking.
3. Each booth will be charged a rate of \$50.00 for each location and 15% of gross sales after the first \$100.00. The booth fee is not refundable.  
ALL SALES BY TICKETS ONLY – NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. All concessions must be fully equipped and ready for operation during these hours. However, you may open earlier and stay longer depending on crowd attendance.
5. You will be responsible, during the Fair, to maintain the area surrounding your booth. Failure to do so may result in closing of your booth.
6. **You will be allowed to sell only what is specified and granted by the agreement and application. This includes water.**
7. No sound equipment such as P. A. systems or record players will be allowed. Bring electrical cords and posters for items sold if needed.
8. No selling or roving the grounds will be permitted. A concession must abide by these rules and guidelines.
9. All concessions will operate only in assigned areas as agreed. Outdoor booths will be furnished 110 electricity if needed and an area of 15' X 15'. No tables, tents or booths will be provided. You will be responsible for providing your own facility.
10. The concession committee shall have complete authority and approval on items sold, and will be selective to insure an adequate range of services available.
11. An infraction or failure to abide by these rules and guidelines can result in the closing of your booth.
12. The Medina County Fair Association assumes no liability for products sold by concessionaires.
13. Concessionaires are responsible for the sales tax on their products.
14. Any concession using and/or selling a product that requires ice must purchase the ice from the Medina County Fair Association, Inc.
15. All vehicles owned by concessionaires and/or workers must be parked in the parking lot during hours from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The only exception will be emergency First Aid Vehicles.

As per Medina County Environmental Health Department, you will need to submit a current food service permit with your application and have it on display at your booth at all times. Your application will not be accepted without this permit.
